Professional Development Advisory Council (PDAC) (Goal I)

Purpose:

Provide leadership that advances professional development of nurse educators.

Objectives:

1. Identify strategies to promote mentoring amongst nurse educators.
2. Increase opportunities for development of nurse educators.
3. Promote best practices in nursing education.
4. Disseminate information related to trends in nursing education.
5. Promote achievement of the NLN competencies for nurse educators.

Educational Leadership Advisory Council (ELAC) (Goal II)

Purpose:

Provide insight to current issues, trends and practices in nursing which bridge education, practice and research.

Objectives:

1. Gather data related to the utilization of new graduates.
2. Identify strategies to enhance the new graduate transition
